RE: Properties located in a FEMA Declared Disaster Area

**Effective immediately**, Cornerstone Correspondent Lending (CLD) will not require an inspection on properties located in a FEMA declared disaster area.

<u>We will require</u> a completed Certification of Property Condition Prior to Closing (see attached). This document is also posted on the correspondent web site: <u>www.chlcorrespondent.com</u> in the Forms section.

This requirement will remain in effect until 120 days after the expiration date of the declared disaster for the counties listed in such declaration.

The following is a list of all Texas counties that have a Federal Disaster Declaration issued as of June 6th, 2015:

Bastrop, Blanco, Caldwell, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Eastland, Fannin, Fort Bend, Gaines, Grayson, Guadalupe, Harris, Hays, Henderson, Hildago, Johnson, Liberty, Milam, Montague, Navarro, Nueces, Rusk, Smith, Travis, Van Zandt, Walker, Wichita, Williamson, and Wise.
